

CITY OF FOREST HILLS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
APRIL 8, 2019

Mayor Kenny Griffin opened the regular meeting at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was held in the Community of Christ Church.

City Commissioner Members: Kenny Griffin (Mayor), Sharon Doll (Public Works), Sharon Henry (Finance/ Landscaping), Gayle Knoop (Safety), and Lydia Moel (Sanitation/ Events).

City Employees: NSAP Lt. Hondro Cabrera (Police Officer), John Singler (Attorney), and Mark Madison (City Engineer/ Code Enforcement Officer). Pat Cooke (Clerk/ Treasurer) was absent.

Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call: All present except Pat Cooke.

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Commissioner Lydia Moel to accept, Commissioner Sharon Henry seconded, and all approved.

Reports:

Finance: Comm. Sharon Henry reports \$367,626.00 in checking and savings account. Motion to pay bills made by Comm. Henry, seconded by Comm. Sharon Doll, and all approved.

Landscape: Comm. Sharon Henry reports that she investigated why the entrance lights on Narwood are out and not working. She had an electrician investigate, he said that the power had been cut, and submitted an estimate to fix the lights at \$3,800.00. Problem appears to be caused by the AT&T project which is being done by Star Construction. John Singler will follow up with Star Construction. Sharon Henry reported a need to clean up and plant trees in common area and asked the Commission to allocate funds for the project. Comm. Sharon Henry made motion to allocate \$5,000.00 to the common areas project, Comm. Lydia Moel seconded, and all approved.

Sanitation: Com. Lydia Moel reports new recycle bins have been delivered and there will be an Easter Egg Hunt soon.

Public Safety: Com. Gail Knoop reports that there has not been much activity. There was one citation issued and several warnings. Speeding is slowing down after more Radar Enforcement.

Public Works: Comm. Sharon Doll discussed several property maintenance issues that John Singler will follow up on. U.S. Post will repair traffic signs and MSD will repair depression in Road.

Clerk's Report: Clerk, Pat Cooke is absent but she left some notes for the Mayor to read. Newsletter has been sent out. Commissioners should be doing first reading in May of the Tax and Budget Ordinances. The sale of the vacant lots on Axminster did not go through.


Attorney Report: John Singler informed the Commission that Metro Louisville did not increase the insurance premium tax and therefore Forest Hills rate must remain the same.

Engineers Report: Mark Madison discussed for the encroachment permit with Kentucky Transportation Cabinet.


Open Comments: Several Residents reported that they are getting signatures together for a petition to install speed humps.
