REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 4, 2019

Mayor Kenny Griffin opened the regular meeting at 6:00 p.m. Meeting was held in the Community of Christ Church.

City Commissioner Members: Kenneth Griffin (Mayor), Sharon Doll (Public Works), Sharon Henry (Finance/Landscaping), Gayle Knoop (Safety), and Lydia Moel (Sanitation/Events).

Roll Call: All present except Com. Knoop and Mark Madison (due to change in time)

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Com. Moel to approve the minutes, seconded by Com. Henry. Motion carried.

Reports:

Finance: Com. Henry reported various accounts had a total of \$378,700 and taxes receivable are \$4,980. She then made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Com. Doll. A draft of the 2018 audit had been reviewed by the Board. Com. Henry made a motion to accept the 2018 Audit, seconded by Com. Moel. Motion carried.

Com. Henry said that the dead tree in the cemetery had been removed. Resident Ken Minyard had won the drawing for the free tree donated by Eco Systems. Lights are out at the Narwood entrance and John Waters will take care of fixing the problem.

Sanitation: Very quiet.

Public Safety: Com.

Public Works: Repair work has been completed at the corner of Axminster. The City is waiting for the street lamp to be installed at the corner of Narwood and Mahan and also MSD to take care of the work order for the depression on Narwood and Mahan.

City Clerk: The Clerk will be out of town from March 5th through the 12th. She asked that the Board approve the draft of the new magnet. Com. Moel made a motion to approve, seconded by Com. Henry, motion carried.

City Attorney: Mr. Singler gave the second reading of Ordinance #3 pertaining to the insurance rate that Louisville Metro is trying to get passed. Com. Henry made a motion to approve the ordinance, seconded by Com. Doll, motion carried.

He contacted Star Construction about the tree trimming mess they left when doing contract work for AT&T behind properties on Narwood. They are supposed to clean this up.


There has been no info or activity on the property sold off of Axminster and nothing going on with the Walmart property.


