

CITY OF FOREST HILLS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES NOVEMBER 12, 2018

Mayor Griffin opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was held in the Community of Christ Church. City Commission Members: Kenneth Griffin (Mayor), Sharon Doll (public works), Sharon Henry (Finance), Susie Strange (Public Safety), and Lydia Moel (Sanitation). Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call: All Present, except the City Clerk. There was a quorum to conduct business. John Singler (Attorney) recorded the minutes in the absence of the City Clerk.

REPORTS:

Minutes. Motion made by Sharon Henry to approve the minutes, seconded by Sharon Doll and the vote in favor was unanimous.

Finance: Commissioner Henry. Motion by Sharon Henry to approve Treasurer report, seconded by Sharon Doll and the vote in favor was unanimous. Commissioner Henry discussed the leaf removal operation, which has been going well and there have been several compliments. She discussed Tree Grant Program and suggested the commission re-approve same amount of \$10,000 for the year. She handed out a municipal order approving tree grant program and made a motion to approve, seconded by Susie Strange and the vote in favor was unanimous. Sharon Henry discussed a complaint about a dead tree in the cemetery that she got an estimate of \$4,500 for removal. She feels that the estimate is high and will get a second estimate.

Sanitation: Commissioner Lydia Moel received a complaint about a late-night dumpster pick up. Officer Hondro Cabrera investigated and the dumpster pick up appears to be temporary and related to the clear out of the Walmart store. Commissioner Moel discussed the rut at the entrance to Axminster and it did not remain fixed and needs a permanent repair. City engineer Mark Madison said that a permanent repair would require building an additional road at the entrance. Lydia Moel made a motion to approve up to \$5,000 for the project, Sharon Doll seconded, and the vote in favor was unanimous. Commissioner Moel has received complaints about a large boat being parked, the property conditions at 9017 Taylorsville Rd. and also parking issues at the end of Axminster that the commission discussed and will look into.

Safety: Commissioner Strange reported that there have been no calls or complaints other than a complaint about parking in the grass which was not substantiated.


Public Works: Commissioner Doll has received complaints about cars being broken into at the 2300 block of Cherian Dr. Officer Hondro Cabrera was informed and will look into the situation. Sharon Doll responded to an inquiry from Worthington Hills about what the city pays for garbage collection. She brought up the holiday event during next month's meeting and that the catering will be supplied by Halls Catering and that the city needs to change the time for the meeting to 6PM. Commissioner Doll made a motion to change the meeting time to 6PM on December 10th, seconded by Susie Strange and the vote in favor was unanimous.

The commission discussed creating a separate flyer on how to sign up for REACH alerts.

With no further business, Mayor Griffin adjourned the meeting at 7:30 p.m.
