Meeting Minutes

January 15, 2018

All present:

Mayor Griffin, Commissioners Sharon Doll, Susie Strange, Lydia Moel, John Singler and Hondro Cabrera.

Sharon Henry was not able to attend the meeting due to a change date of the meeting by the Mayor.

Meeting started at 7:00 p.m.

Previous minutes reviewed. Lydia made one correction. Susie made a motion to approve the previous minutes with change. Sharon Doll seconded motion.

Sharon Henry Report: (per email)

Total invoice for Greenway leaf removal totaled \$11,450. This was \$4,950 under our budget amount. We were unsure exactly how to put an initial cost to the project due to the first time it was implemented. The projected cost was based on riding through the city observing trees. Many residents yard service mulched leaves and did not require the leaf removal service. Eighty residents did take advantage of the service and provided good feedback.

I would like to bring up the sidewalk in front of 19 Narwood. I know there was a death in the family and we let it slide. The sidewalk is covered in mud from the resident driving thru the yard which contains large muddy ruts. Someone is going to fall in the slick mud, could be me, and I think the residents should clean the sidewalk and stop driving off the driveway.

The home on 2206 Janlyn, auctioned off last week, has workers at the house. I have notified Bob Kirtzinger not to cut grass there this Spring."

There was a discussion about getting other bids for leaf removal for next fall. Everyone agreed that would be a good idea.

Lydia made a motion to pay the bills, Sharon Doll seconded motion.

Lydia Report:

Gift cards were delivered to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in Holiday decorating contest. Waste collection schedule for 2018 should be up on website.

Susie Report:

7 traffic stops, 4 parking, 1 pedestrian

A resident on Narwood called Susie about a tent that they saw pitched behind Walmart. Hondro contacted the property maintenance guy @ Walmart. The tent has since been removed.

Sharon Doll Report:

Stop sign was put up at Hurstbourne Village. Everything else has been quiet.

John Singler Report:

John pulled the Land Development Report for the Tree Forest- it is owned by the Village Square shopping center. A discussion was had about potentially buying that area.

John reviewed the rezoning for 9101 Taylorsville rd. He said that things are moving slowly right now. When they get serious about moving forward we can look at limiting c-1 uses. Not currently ready for action.


Pat's Report:


