

CITY OF FOREST HILLS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 12, 2018

Mayor Kenny Griffin opened the regular meeting at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was held in the Community of Christ Church.

City Commissioner Members: Kenneth Griffin (Mayor), Sharon Doll (Public Works), Sharon Henry (Finance/Landscaping), Susie Strange (Safety), and Lydia Moel (Sanitation).

City Employees: NSAP Lt. Hondro Cabrera (police officer), Pat Cooke (Clerk/Treasurer), John Singler (Attorney) and Mark Madison (City Engineer & Code Enforcement Officer).

Others Present: Jim and Linda Ayres from Church

Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call: All present except Lt. Cabrera who had to leave.

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and a motion to approve was made by Com. Doll, seconded by Com. Henry. Motion carried.

The Mayor recognized Linda Ayres. She gave a report on the progress of the renovation of the Church and estimated it would be completed hopefully in about three months. Also, visitors will be parking their RV in the Church parking lot for a few days in the next week.

Reports:

Finance: Com. Henry reported that money in various accounts totaled \$392,316 and there are only \$2036 owed in 2017 property taxes receivable. Com. Doll made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Com. Moel.

Com. Henry also reported one reimbursement of \$250 for tree work by one of the residents.

Sanitation: Received just a few calls. Com. Moel requested a budget of \$300 for the Easter Egg Hunt. She then made a motion for the \$300, seconded by Com. Doll. She also suggested that for the summer picnic, that the City hire a food truck to provide a fixed menu which would allow the Board to enjoy the picnic as well. This was received with enthusiasm by the Board and Com. Moel will look into what food trucks are possible.

There was mention that the garbage can at Axminster is going to need to be removed when the sidewalk work begins.

Public Safety: There has been minor activity in the City. Lt. Cabrera did talk to the owner of the house where several cars were parking on the lawn and the owner assured Lt. Cabrera that it would be taken care of.

Public Works: Just one reported mailbox issue and a street light out and reported.

City Clerk: Almost all the 2017 property taxes have been paid. The Clerk will be on vacation from March 20th thru the 27th.


City Attorney: The RV issued seems to be resolved for now. A landscape plan has been filed for the Hwang property. He also commented that our audit was very positive in our budget.
